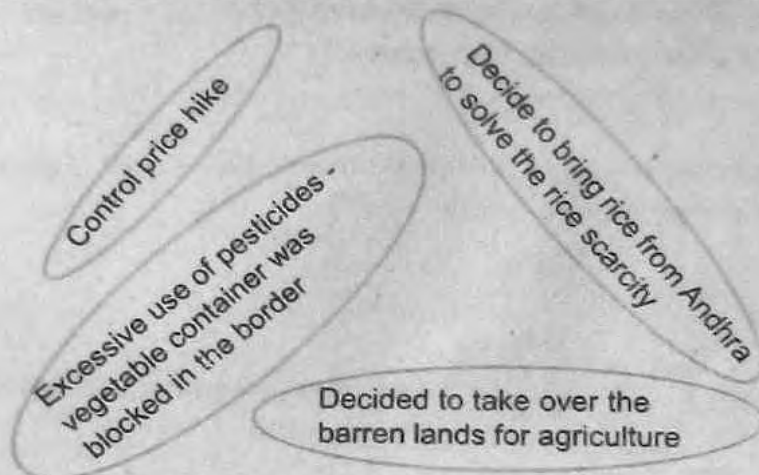

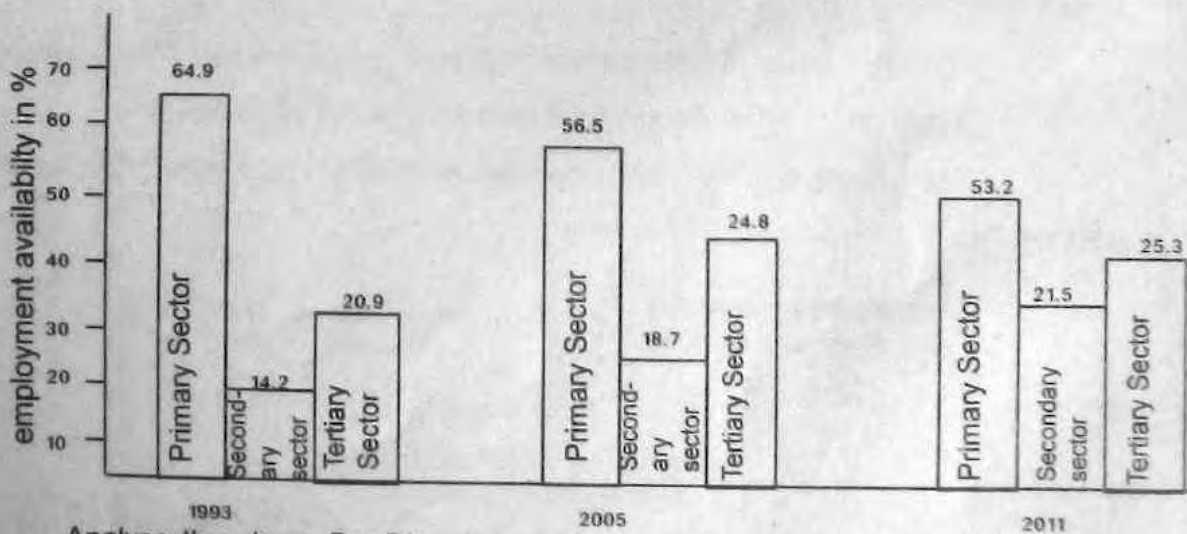
**Activity - 1**
